

DonorNet® User Session “Smooth Sailing with DonorNet”- NATCO 2008 feedback

Around thirty DonorNet® users, representing both the OPO and transplant communities, voluntarily attended this educational session on Tuesday August 12, from 6 -9p.m. UNOS staff kicked the evening off by answering specific questions from the audience and presenting slides covering some new DonorNet® features.
