DonorNet®2007 is a national system to uniformly display donor data and make electronic organ offers quickly and efficiently. This system builds upon the strengths and proven advantages of the current DonorNet for presenting donor information in a consistent manner to transplant centers.

In addition, DonorNet2007 will enable OPOs to make multiple simultaneous organ offers using current telecommunications technologies to improve the efficiency of the allocation process. This new organ offer process focuses priority on quickly registering the organ refusals so the donor coordinator can focus their limited time and resources on those transplant centers that have indicated interest in the organ.

## Why create an electronic placement system?

- To improve the efficiency of the organ placement process, from creation of the donor record and running the match, to all OPO-transplant center interactions related to the offer, evaluation and placement of donated organs.
- To align with HHS' Program Goals to achieve the yield of 3.75 organs per donor, and achieve a 75% conversion rate. As the community reaches these goals, more organs will be available and in need of efficient placement.
- To meet the OPTN contract requirement that a system to “electronically notify transplant programs of available compatible organs” be developed.

### Electronic Organ Placement Working Group

Established by the OPTN Operations Committee to address policy and process issues related to implementing the electronic organ placement system, this group serves as a resource to UNOS IT staff for the development and implementation of the DonorNet2007 system. Members are:

## Schedule of Events

On April 30, 2007, DonorNet2007 will become the national system for organ placement. Prior to April 2007, design, testing and pilot use of the system will be occurring in two phases:

Design Phase	Technical Focus
<b>Phase I</b> Released for use nationally on 4/29/2006	OPO donor data collection and display of donor information for review by transplant center personnel.
<b>Phase II</b> Released for use nationally in early December 2006	Electronic notification and on-line organ offer process.
